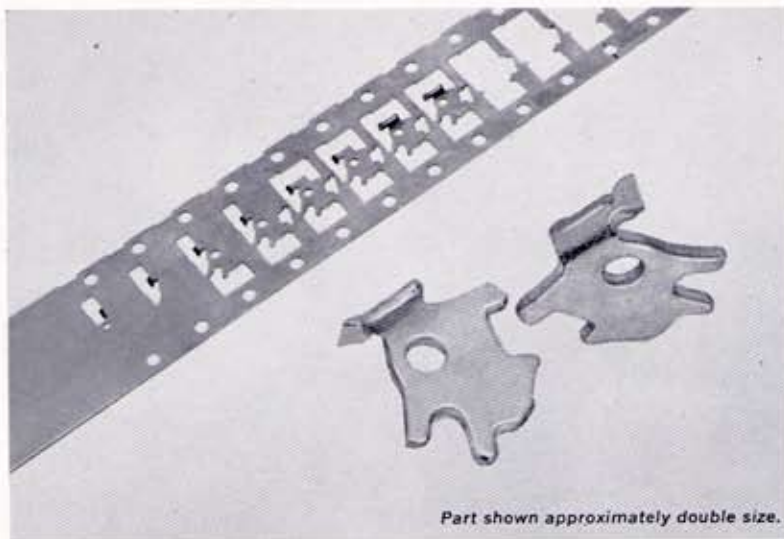

Smith-Corona buys Minster press precision to safeguard progressive dies

Minster P2 Piece-Maker® presses are used for progressive, close tolerance production of intricate typewriter parts at Smith-Corona, Division of SCM Corporation, Cortland, N. Y.

They knew, for sure, that the exceptional precision Minster builds into the Piece-Maker press matches the needs of their many complex and expensive progressive dies. They know this precision protects those dies during high speed, high volume runs.

In addition to this security, Smith-Corona realizes increased productivity due to higher speeds and the availability of high volume runs. In the case of the part shown here, by the elimination of one secondary operation, substantial manufacturing savings are made on nearly 13 million parts per year. Piece-Maker presses range from 16 to 800 tons.
